This Program provides:

Assistance for young people to make the transition from school to adult life. The program empowers each participant to develop the skills necessary for them to participate within their community and adopt valued roles in their families.

The Program also supports parents and carers to plan for the young person's future by identifying the networks and skills needed to ensure they have every chance of achieving success.

At Burnett Respite Services, we run a variety of Day Programs for Post School Services clients Monday to Friday between the hours of 9:00am and 3:00pm.

Meals on Wheels — Cooking Club

The Meals on Wheels/Carinbundi Cooking Club is a partnership between Bundaberg and District Meals on Wheels and Burnett Respite Services Inc. aimed at giving participants the skills to identify and prepare healthy, inexpensive meals. The Club runs for most of the year and concludes with a sit-down lunch prepared and served to parents, carers and invited guests. An individual cookbook is developed over the life of the program and presented at the luncheon.

Life-skills and sporting events are two key components of a balanced program



Eligibility:

To be eligible for the Post School Services Program, a young person must:

- be 18 by 31 January in the year they enter the Program;
- be exiting or have exited special school or special education programs and/or services;
- have a level of disability that results in high and complex support needs;
- be eligible for assistance under the Queensland Disability Services Act 2006; and not have access to tertiary, vocational training or employment options.



When designing an individual program for a young person attending our Post School Services Program, some of the many activities we look to offer include:

- Community Involvement
- Afternoon Physical Activities Program
- Basic Computer Skills
- Art Expression
- Vegetable and herb Gardening
